TRACK WORK

It is now possible to make the short loop through the yard. There is still a section of four-plus panels through the station which is old track and, of course, the yard might be an adventure, but the route is there now. Bill Kinzer led a special Sunday crew (although they did not sign in on the Work Record!) to finish the other remaining gap on this loop. Bob Schwoerer has been laid up for a while with a problem knee – too much aggravation laying track, probably.

The immediate focus now might be the first switch to the yard immediately past the driveway crossing. That switch does not have much to do with the rehab of the inside track, but it has a lot to do with reasonable operations being performed. Its location appears to subject it to bad drainage and the ties have suffered severely. Some members have to step up to take responsibility for discussing possible corrective actions with President Larry Law in the event that the switch itself is not rebuilt in the very near future.

Work must continue on the rebuild of the inside track. Replacement of the final section at the station will represent a true milestone, but a tremendous amount of work remains. In fact, there are not enough panels built to finish the remaining track. Please, do not think that there is no work for you to do!
