## TRACK WORK

Was it rather pleasant weather during the early part of January? Seems the track installation crew thought so. The entire horseshoe around the elevated track was completed. On January 6, a good-sized crew installed 18 panels putting the end-of-track at the beginning of the Midway straight. That stretch beats the 17 panels installed on a Saturday in October. Seems that the crew has gotten smaller or the weather cooler because no more track has been laid since. Not to worry too much; attention has turned to building track which will be needed for the Midway straight and approach to the 75 foot radius horseshoe in the southwest.

With the new inner loop track nosing at Midway Straight, the time has come to DO something about the drainage problems along that lowland stretch of track. An idea is to install a drain along the inside of the inner loop with as many as four drains crossing under both tracks to carry the water out to the scrub land between the horseshoes. One of the design thoughts is to replace sections of the outer loop with new wood-tie panels where the drains cross under. Using the old-style panels would alleviate any problem with changing the rail ends to accept the new joiners. Of course, changing ends might be easier than screwing all those bolts for the fish-plate rail joiners. And think of the drilling that has to be done, too...

### **HYDRAULICS**

The hydraulic lines failed on the Massey-Ferguson during the heavy track laying action, and Mike Taber made up a new set which were installed by Bob Schwoerer. Now we need less-cold (i.e., much warmer) weather to put the bucket back to work.

### **INSPECTIONS**

Tentative dates set for the annual inspections – nothing firm yet. Lou Koehler will try to get the inspectors to agree to a Saturday session for boiler inspections on Friday, April 13 and Saturday, the 14<sup>th</sup>. It is hoped to have car inspections on April 11 or 18.
